#314 Rectangular Niche	#305 Narrow Combo Niche	#306 Narrow Arch Combo Niche	<h2>Noble Niche Installation Instructions</h2> <h3>1.0 Product &amp; Materials</h3> <p>1.1 Noble Niches: are made from high density, extruded polystyrene (XPS) and coated with an acrylic polymer finish. Noble Niches are waterproof and ready-to-tile. They are lightweight, durable and are not a food source for fungus and mold.</p> <p>1.2 Other Tools &amp; Materials Needed: Saw (for cutting backer board), backer board tape, and 100% silicone sealant.</p> <h3>2.0 Installing into 2" x 4" stud wall</h3> <p>2.1 Determine desired height of Niche.</p> <p>2.2 Draw level line between studs at this location.</p> <p>2.3 Place Niche on level line.</p> <p>2.4 Trace outside edge of Niche.</p> <p>2.5 Cut and remove panel.</p> <p>NOTE: Use appropriate rough-in framing.</p> <p>2.6 Use a 100% silicone sealant to adhere Niche to back wall and/or studs.</p> <p>2.7 Seal joints between Niche and backer board using 100% silicone sealant. Silicone should not be smeared over the face of the Niche or backer board.</p> <p>2.8 Tape joints with backer board tape or bond NobleSeal® TS to walls and overlap joints.</p> <p>2.9 Install tile using latex modified thin-set.</p> <p><b>NOTES:</b> For any situation not specifically covered, contact our Technical Department before proceeding. Follow TCNA Guidelines.</p>
